



By car

Take the motorway Zurich-Chur, exit Wollerau, direction Schindellegi/Feusisberg. Free, outdoor parking is available, underground car park CHF 15 per day.

By train from Zurich

Take the S-Bahn No. 2 to Pfäffikon SZ (every 60 minutes) where taxis are available that will take you to the Panorama Resort & Spa in less than 10 minutes or you can reserve a shuttle service. Cost CHF 10 per person. For the shuttle service, please fill in your arrival time on the registration form.
